Camp at Kibo Crater - An exciting option to this Category is to spend the night with a small support team in the crater of Kilimanjaro at 5729m (18,791ft) either after or before summiting. Health and strength permitting, this option allows us to launch excursions to a number of fascinating and rarely seen features within the crater like the Reusch Ash Pit at the crater's center to the rapidly retreating edges of the northern and eastern ice fields. Camp facilities are top notch for this "Once in life time" trip. This option is for Lemosho route, Machame, Umbwe and Rongai Northern Circuit.

Deluxe Service - Category B:

Weight allowed on personal belongs: 14kg/28lbs

Food: English breakfast - Lunch packed or hot - Three course dinners - Dessert

Camp Facilities:

Dining tent with lights and camp chairs with back support -

Four season tents with extra space.

This is our most popular option. It offers you a high level of support with hearty and satisfying food like fresh fruits, vegetables, meat, and local cuisine. Budget Service - Category C:

Weight allowed on personal belongs: 10kg /20lbs

Food: Continental Breakfast - Trail Lunch with Sandwich - Hot dinner with two courses

A lightweight, traditional alpinist style, you'll be required to carry 5 -10 kg and will only be able to give 10 kg (20 lbs) to your porter. Some foods will be dehydrated and mess tents will not be used. This can be provided at no cost for 4 or more climbers or at an additional charge for smaller groups. This Category is recommended only for very active and self-sufficient climbers. No Airport pick-ups, drops off, or hotel accommodations are included. They can be booked at extra cost. If you require airport transfers and/or hotel accommodations, please request and we will check availability and costs.

Typical climber to staff support ratios are: 1:4, 2:7, 3:10, 4:12, 5:15, 6:18, 7:22, 8:25.

We encourage you to bring your own personal gear rather than renting. Shoes, warm trousers, jackets, gloves and wool socks may be difficult to find in your size. We stock the highest quality sleeping bags and ground pads for rental.
